## 7:1-5 I. God's people must avoid all spiritual compromise.

- **:1, 2a** A. We must represent God's interests. *"...and when the Lord your God gives them over to you...you must devote them to complete destruction."*
- :2b B. We must look to God alone for protection. "You shall make no covenant with them...."
- **:3,4** C. We must unite our hearts with those who love Him. *"You shall not intermarry with them..."*
- **:5** D. We must love what He loves and hate what He hates. *"...you shall break down their altars and dash in pieces their pillars and chop down their Asherim and burn their carved images with fire."*
- :6-10 II. God has made us distinctive.

"For you are a people holy to the Lord your God."

- **:6-8** A. Our distinction is His electing love. *"The Lord has chosen you to be a people for his treasured possession out of all the people on the face of the earth." "...it is because the Lord loves you."*
- **:9-10** B. His love is based on His character. *"...the faithful God who keeps covenant and steadfast love with those who love him... and repays...those who hate him."*

:11-26	<b>III. Living distinctly has enormous consequences.</b> <i>"You shall therefore be careful"</i>
:11-16	A. God blesses us greatly. <i>"He will love you, bless you, and multiply you"</i>
:17-24	B. We need not fear. "you shall not be afraid of them but you shall remember"
:25-26	C. We must destroy the idols. <i>"The carved images of their gods you shall burn with fire."</i>
:25	1. They ensnare. "lest you be ensnared by it"
:26	<ol> <li>They offend God.</li> <li>"for it is an abomination to the Lord your Godan abominable thingutterly detest and abhor"</li> </ol>

:26 3. They destroy you. "And you shall not...become devoted to destruction like it."
