James: Possessing Real Faith James 2:14-26 October 20, 2016

#### I. Faith without works is useless.

## A. It does not save.

<sup>14</sup> What good is it, my brothers, if someone says he has faith but does not have works? Can that faith save him?

cf. John 2:23-25

# B. It does not help others.

<sup>15</sup> If a brother or sister is poorly clothed and lacking in daily food, <sup>16</sup> and one of you says to them, "Go in peace, be warmed and filled," without giving them the things needed for the body, what good is that?

cf. Luke 10:25-37; Acts 2:44, 45; 4:32-35; II Corinthians 8:8-15; Galatians 6:9-10

## C. It is dead.

<sup>17</sup> So also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead. <sup>18</sup> But someone will say, "You have faith and I have works." Show me your faith apart from your works, and I will show you my faith by my works. cf. Matthew 25:31-46; Galatians 2:17-21; Romans 3:31; Romans 6:14

## II. Faith without works is devilish.

<sup>19</sup> You believe that God is one; you do well. Even the demons believe—and shudder! cf. Acts 8:13

#### III. Faith without works is unbiblical.

<sup>20</sup> Do you want to be shown, you foolish person, that faith apart from works is useless?

# A. Consider Abraham

<sup>21</sup> Was not Abraham our father justified by works when he offered up his son Isaac on the altar? <sup>22</sup> You see that faith was active along with his works, and faith was completed by his works; <sup>23</sup> and the Scripture was fulfilled that says, "Abraham believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness"—and he was called a friend of God. <sup>24</sup> You see that a person is justified by works and not by faith alone.

cf. Genesis 22:9, 12; 15:6

#### B. Consider Rahab

<sup>25</sup> And in the same way was not also Rahab the prostitute justified by works when she received the messengers and sent them out by another way? <sup>26</sup> For as the body apart from the spirit is dead, so also faith apart from works is dead.

cf. Joshua 2
