PREPARATION FOR WORSHIP

*As you enter the Sanctuary, please prepare your heart for worship
and silence your mobile devices.*

Many biblical texts aid us in praising God. On occasion, we incorporate other ancient texts and creeds to facilitate worship. One such example is the “Te Deum,” which literally means in Latin, “You O God.” Our choir will sing this ancient text during our offering. For centuries, skilled musicians have used this hymn that dates back to the 4th century. It has been put to hundreds of musical settings, including this one by the great Austrian composer, Franz Joseph Haydn.

The “Te Deum” reminds us of the privilege we have to join our voices with many others who praise God today with us: The angelic host, the apostles, the prophets, the martyrs, the church triumphant in heaven, and the church militant around the world.

You have not only come to a physical house of God today, but “you have come to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to innumerable angels in festal gathering, and to the assembly of the firstborn who are enrolled in heaven, and to God, the judge of all... Therefore let us be grateful for receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, and thus let us offer to God acceptable worship, with reverence and awe” (Hebrews 12:22-23, 28).
