# 5:1-2 I. We rejoice in our hope of glory.

A. We stand on of our past justification.

<sup>1</sup>Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, ...

# :1b-2a B. We enjoy our present benefits.

...we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. <sup>2</sup>Through him we have also obtained access by faith into this grace in which we stand, ...

# :2b C. We anticipate our future glory.

...and we rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

## :3-5 II. We rejoice in our sufferings.

<sup>3</sup>Not only that, but we rejoice in our sufferings...

## :3b A. Suffering produces perseverance.

...knowing that suffering produces endurance, ...

# :4a B. Perseverance produces character.

<sup>4</sup>and endurance produces character, ...

#### :4b-5 C. Character produces hope.

...and character produces hope, <sup>5</sup> and hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.

## :6-10 III. We rejoice in our salvation.

#### :6-8 A. Christ shed His blood for His enemies.

<sup>6</sup> For while we were still weak, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly. <sup>7</sup> For one will scarcely die for a righteous person—though perhaps for a good person one would dare even to die— <sup>8</sup> but God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

# :9, 10 B. How much more shall we be saved?

1. His death guarantees His future salvation.

<sup>9</sup> Since, therefore, we have now been justified by his blood, much more shall we be saved by him from the wrath of God.

### 2. His past grace toward enemies guarantees His future grace toward friends.

<sup>10</sup> For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by his life.

# :11 **IV. We rejoice in God.**

<sup>11</sup> More than that, we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received reconciliation.
